

## BRITISH COLUMBIA BEREAVEMENT CHECKLIST

The death of a loved one is a difficult part of life; family members and those close to the deceased are often left to handle various administrative tasks which must take place. This checklist is a tool that can assist with identifying key federal departments and provincial ministries that should be notified of a death to terminate benefits and services or to initiate benefits for survivors.

**Please note:** An original or copy of a death certificate may be required; the requirements vary by program area.

 Please notify if the deceased had or has applied for a Permanent Resident Card, or if they have Canadian Citizenship documents. A copy of the death certificate is required.

## Vehicle Registration and Insurance

Vehicle ownership needs to be transferred into the estate, to the surviving spouse, beneficiary or to a purchaser – then the insurance cancelled. Documents will vary depending on situation.

## Interest in land

You will need to transfer ownership in any interest in land to the estate or transmit the interest to the surviving joint tenant. Life estates need to be cancelled. Documents required will vary depending on the situation.

### **Social Insurance Number (SIN)**

You are no longer required to inform Service Canada of the death if the death occurred in the following provinces: Alberta, British Columbia, Manitoba, Nova Scotia, Ontario, Prince Edward Island or Quebec. The notification of death is received electronically from the Vital Statistics Agencies of these provinces. For these specific provinces, you can destroy the deceased person's SIN card if you have it in your possession. For deaths that occurred in provinces that do not send electronic death notifications to Service Canada, a copy of the death certificate is required.

**BC Employment and Assistance - Income, Disability and Hardship Assistance**

A supplement may be provided to pay necessary funeral costs of any person who dies in B.C., if the estate of the deceased person or any responsible person has no immediate resources to meet these costs. There is no requirement that the deceased person, or the person's family, must be recipients of BC Employment and Assistance to qualify for the supplement. Survivors of fatally injured workers need to notify WorkSafeBC (WCB) of their loved one's death to terminate benefits. A copy of a death certificate may be required to claim survivor benefits due to a workplace death.
