Most bus routes are now accessible. When calling for route information be sure to mention that you require lift equipped or low floor service and an accessible stop. Coverage across the city is extensive. Skytrain from airport to downtown and other parts of the Lower Mainland is fully accessible.

HandyDART is part of the larger
public transit system. It is a door-to-door service for those unable to
access conventional transit services.
Rides can now be booked up to
seven days in advance. You must
pre-register, and provide a doctor's
note, so it is most suitable for those
who plan to be in the area for a while.
